Investment opportunities in the agriculture and fishing sector in Algeria

1. The advantages of Algerian agriculture

- Possibility to provide on the market all along the year, and also off season.

Algeria encourages foreign companies with the skills and knowledge required, to invest with local partners in strategic sectors in order to privileging concrete projects capable of quick results for a win-win situation.

It is appropriate to recall that foreign investment will be carried out in accordance with Article 58 of the Supplementary Finance Act of 2009, the foreign partner holds 49% of the share capital of the company created in partnership

New needs have been strongly expressed in the field in terms of investments both upstream and downstream of the production, in the packaging, recycling and processing of fruits, vegetables, meats, fishing products and aquaculture, and in the field of agricultural and aquacultural production.
